- → Bharatiya Nyaya(Second) Sanhita 2023 implements death penalty for mob lynching replacing the Indian Penal Code 1860. The term 'Sedition' has been removed, exchanging it for 'treason' with clearer definitions aimed at preserving freedom of expression.
- → The updated law encompasses 358 sections, including 21 new offences, stricter penalties and provisions for community service punishments.



Press and Registration of Periodicals Bill:

- → Anurag Thakur announced the Parliament's approval of the 2023 Press and Registration of Periodicals Bill. The bill plans to simplify the online process for periodical registration, facilitating press procedures.
- ➔ Providing for newspaper circulation and verification, the legislation requires Central Government consent for the local publication of foreign periodicals.



"Panic Button"?

- → Central Railway introduced "Panic Button" safety feature for women. Red push buttons installed within each of the four ladies coaches will trigger an alert in emergencies. Until this installation, women relied on helpline calls, SMS chain pulling on emergencies.
- → Pushing the button situated next to the alarm chain will activate an audio and visual signal on flasher units outside the coach alerting platform staff and fellow passengers.




UNESCO:

- → It includes financial aid for top-class education, free coaching for SCs/OBSs a fellowship for SC students and an overseas scheme.




