(Importance level-3/5)


- → WHO has awarded its first-ever certificates validating progress in eliminating industrially produced trans fatty acids to five countries.







- This female robot astronaut simulates human functions in the space environment, interacting seamlessly with the Life Support System. Its tasks include operating six panels and responding to queries, showcasing its versatility for space exploration.



Banwarilal Purohit:

- → Punjab Governor and Chandigarh Administrator Banwarilal Purohit resigned from his post, citing "personal reasons." 
- → Building on the resounding success of the 2023 edition, India Energy Week 2024 is set to take place in Goa from February 6 to 9, 2024.






- → The Geological Institute of Israel has recently made a groundbreaking discovery near Cyprus, uncovering an underwater canyon of unprecedented proportions.





 - Under this scheme, eligible citizens above the age of 65 will receive financial assistance of three thousand rupees, providing much-needed support and relief to vulnerable members of society.



(Importance level-5/5)



- → The Modi government had announced in the Union Interim Budget presented on February 1 that it would come out with a 'White Paper' to compare the economic performance of 10 years of the Congress-led UPA government with that of 10 years of the BJP-led NDA government.



Reserve Bank of India:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → The Reserve Bank of India has kept the repo rate unchanged at 6.5% for the 6th consecutive time. The decision was made to keep inflation under control, as retail inflation continues to remain above the RBI's target of 4%.
- → RBI Governor Shaktikanda Das projected retail inflation at 5.4% for the current fiscal year and 4.5% for the next fiscal year.



Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has announced that the government will introduce a free bus scheme for transpeople, similar to the scheme for women.
- → The proposal will soon be put before the cabinet and, if approved, will be implemented within a few weeks.

- → The scheme aims to provide convenience and equal rights to the transgender community, which has been neglected for many years.
- → The free bus scheme for women was launched in October 2019 and has been successful thus far. The scheme will be available to all members of the transgender community, regardless of where they live.

- → The Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur (IITK) has achieved a major milestone by successfully establishing and testing India's first hypervelocity expansion tunnel test facility.
- → With this technical facility developed by IIT Kanpur, hypersonic cruise missiles can be prepared for precise targeting.
- → According to IITK, the facility is capable of generating flight speeds between 3-10 km/s, simulating the hypersonic conditions encountered during atmospheric entry.
- → Thus, it is a valuable test facility for ongoing missions of the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) and Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO) including Gaganyaan, RLV (Reusable Launch Vehicle), and hypersonic cruise missiles.



Bina Modi:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → Chairperson of Modi Enterprises, Bina Modi has been honored with the 'Outstanding Business Woman of the Year 2023' award by the Defence Minister of India, Rajnath Singh.
- → The award, presented to her at a prestigious conference by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC) on 'Strengthening Indo-US Relationship in Amritkal-Aatmanirbhar Bharat.



IEA:

(Importance level-4/5)

→ India will in seven years become the largest source of global oil demand growth as its domestic production shrinks 22 per cent, according to the International Energy Agency (IEA).

→ The two trends have major implications as India is already the world's second largest net importer, said the agency in a report released at the India Energy Week in Goa. India's crude imports reached 4.6 million b/d in 2023, increasing 36 per cent in a decade.




EdCIL Vidyanjali Scholarship:

→ Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has launched the EdCIL Vidyanjali Scholarship Programme.

→ The Vidyanjali Scholarship Program symbolizes a whole-of-society approach to empowerment through access and opportunities of education, particularly to students belonging to economically disadvantaged sections.

→ He commended the efforts of students of NVS and mentioned that nearly 14,000 students have succeeded in getting admission to reputed institutes including IITs, NITs, etc. without joining any coaching centres.

- → The UCC aims to standardize laws governing personal matters like marriage, divorce, inheritance, and more across all citizens, irrespective of their religion.
- → Goa is the only state which has a common family law. After its liberation in 1961, Goa, with a population of just six lakh at that time, retained the Portuguese Civil Code, making it the only state to have a uniform civil code for all religions.

Abu Dhabi Investment Authority:

- → The Abu Dhabi Investment Authority (ADIA), the largest sovereign wealth fund in the UAE, is establishing a substantial investment fund totaling \$4-5 billion through India's Gujarat International Finance Tec-City (GIFT City), situated in Prime Minister Narendra Modi's home state.
- → The regulatory authority overseeing financial services at GIFT City has granted in-principle approval to ADIA for setting up the fund. This development marks the first instance of a sovereign wealth fund initiating investments in India via GIFT City.



Indian Institute of Technology Madras:

(Importance level-4/5)

- ➔ Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IIT Madras) has partnered with Munitions India Limited (a Defence Public Sector Enterprise) to develop India's first indigenously-designed 155 Smart Ammunition to achieve indigenization in the defence sector.
- → The objective is to increase the accuracy of 155 mm shell within a Circular Error Probable (CEP) of 10 m. At present, ammunitions developed in India has a CEP of 500 m. Another goal is to increase the lethality at the terminal impact point.

International Monetary Fund:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → International Monetary Fund warns Maldives is at risk of "debt distress" due to excessive borrowing from China.
- → China has increased funding to the Maldives since the pro-china president took office. Maldives's shift in allegiance from India to China has raised concerns about its ability to repay its debts.

- → The planet is dubbed TOI-715 b and is around one and a half times as wide as Earth, and orbits within the "conservative" habitable zone around its parent star, possibly indicating that it may form liquid water on its surface, as per NASA. It completes a full orbit (a year) in just 19 days.



China:

- China launches nine satellites into orbit on powerful Jielong-3 rocket. The Jielong-3, or Smart Dragon-3, blasted off from a floating barge off the coast of Yangjiang in southern Guangdong province.
- → It was the third launch of the rocket, developed by China Rocket Co, a commercial offshoot of a state-owned launch vehicle manufacturer, since December 2022.

- → With this exemption, Indian citizens holding ordinary passports can enter Iran without a visa once every six months for a maximum stay of 15 days.
- → In December, Iran approved a new visa-free programme for India and 32 other countries, including the United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Japan, Singapore and Malaysia.
- → If Indian citizens wish to stay for a longer period or make multiple entries within a six-month period or require other types of visas, it is mandatory to get necessary visas through the respective representations of Iran in India.



India and Saudi Arabia:

- → India and Saudi Arabia recently engaged in discussions aimed at bolstering their bilateral defence and strategic cooperation.
- ➔ These talks, held between Minister of State for Defence Ajay Bhatt and Saudi Arabia's Defence Minister Prince Khalid bin Salman bin Abdulaziz Al-Saud in Riyadh, highlighted several key areas of collaboration.
- → One significant aspect of the discussions was the potential for enhancing joint military training exercises between the two nations. Both sides recognize the importance of interoperability and readiness in addressing shared security challenges.



Wei Yi:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → Grand Master Wei Yi emerged triumphant in the highly anticipated 2024 Tata Steel Chess Tournament, showcasing his exceptional skill and tactical provess.
- → His victory in the thrilling four-player tiebreak, which featured esteemed grandmasters Anish Giri, Gukesh Dommaraju, and Nodirbek Abdusattorov, solidified his position as one of the premier chess players on the global stage. Notably, this victory marks Wei Yi's ascent into the esteemed ranks of the world's top 10 players.

- → The award, established by the UAE government, acknowledges the creative and innovative technological solutions implemented by government entities worldwide.






Kaji nemu:





- → At just 16, he captured Torna fort, followed by Raigad and Kondana forts a year later, marking
 significant milestones in his quest for Hindavi Swarajya, or self-rule in the native language.



Andhra Pradesh Forest Department:

- → The Andhra Pradesh Forest Department, in collaboration with environmentalists, has launched an awareness campaign to commemorate World Pangolin Day on February 17, 2024.
- → Highlighting the plight of the Indian Pangolin (Manis crassicaudata), also known as the Thick-Tailed Pangolin or Scaly Anteater, this initiative underscores the urgent need for conservation efforts for one of the world's most trafficked mammals.
- → The Indian Pangolin, native to the Indian Subcontinent, finds itself under severe threat due to illegal wildlife trade.
- → Despite being protected under Schedule-I of the Indian Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, and listed in Appendix-I of CITES, prohibiting trade in pangolin parts, the species is classified as 'Critically Endangered' on the IUCN Red List.



ISRO:

- → The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) introduces the "Young Scientist Programme" "YUva VIgyani KAryakram" (YUVIKA) to foster the innate curiosity of children and youth towards space science.

Tata Advanced Systems Ltd:




World Peace and Understanding Day:

Ravi River:

- → India has marked the completion of the Shahpur Kandi Barrage on the Ravi River, stopping the water flow to Pakistan, and signifying a strategic shift in water management on February 25, 2024.
- → This long-awaited project, overcoming delays spanning over three decades, now redirects 1,150 cusecs of water towards irrigation purposes in the Kathua and Samba districts of Jammu and Kashmir.
- → This development is reportedly going to bolster agricultural opportunities in the region while also marking a significant change in water allocation in India. Previously, under the 1960 Indus Water Treaty, a portion of the Ravi River's water flowed into Pakistan via the Lakhanpur dam.


Ravi River flow Stirring Pakistan

Sudarshan Setu:

(Importance level-4/5)

→ Prime Minister Narendra Modi will on February 25 dedicate to the nation, Sudarshan Setu, India's longest cable-stayed bridge connecting Okha mainland and Beyt Dwarka island. The inauguration will be done during his visit to Gujarat slated for February 24 and 25.

→ The bridge will ease the transportation and significantly reduce the time of devotees travelling, between Dwarka and Beyt-Dwarka.



Assam government:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → In a step closer to the Uniform Civil code, Assam government has repealed the Muslim Marriage and Divorce Registration Act.
- → Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma, in a social media post, said, "On 23.22024, the Assam cabinet made a significant decision to repeal the age-old Assam Muslim Marriages & Divorces Registration Act.

→ This Act contained provisions allowing marriage registration even if the bride and groom had not reached the legal ages of 18 and 21, as required by law. This move marks another significant step towards prohibiting child marriages in Assam".



Criminal laws:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → The three new criminal laws which replace the Indian Penal Code, Code of Criminal Procedure and Evidence Act will come into effect from July 1, the government notified on Saturday.
- → The three new criminal laws are the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and the Bharatiya Sakshaya Act.
- The new laws aim at a complete overhaul of the British-era laws giving a clear definition of terrorism, abolishing sedition as a crime and introducing a new section titled "offences against the state" -- among many other changes.



Rangpo station:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → Prime Minister Narendra Modi will lay the foundation stone for Sikkim's first railway station Rangpo Station. Rangpo station is the form of a touristic and defensive point of view for Sikkim and India, Basically, Sikkim did not have a railway line earlier.
- → The government has signed this project in three phases. In the first phase, Sevoke to the Rangpo rail project; in the other phase, from Rangpo to Gangtok; and the third phase, from Gangtok to Nathula.



Balakot Airstrike Day:

- → 26 February: Balakot Airstrike Day: The Balakot airstrike, conducted on February 26, 2019, was a meticulously planned and executed operation that demonstrated India's unwavering commitment to national security.
- → The codeword "Bandar Mara Gaya" was reportedly used to relay the success of the mission, signalling the elimination of a significant threat.





Defence Security Corps:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → Defence Security Corps (DSC) is celebrating its 77th Raising Day today. The Corps was raised on this day in 1947 as 'Defence Department Constabulary'.
- → DSC troops have been providing security to various sensitive defence and civil installations across the length and breadth of the Country since 1947.





Uttarakhand government:

- → The Uttarakhand government is all set to introduce the 'Uttarakhand Public and Private Property Damage Recovery Bill' during the budget session commencing on Monday.
- → Although Uttarakhand has generally remained a peaceful state, government sources indicate that the need for legislation arose after the recent riots in Haldwani.
- → Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami has reaffirmed the government's commitment to recovering
 - damages amounting to crores from the individuals accused of rioting in the Haldwani incident.



NITI Aayog:

- → The latest consumer expenditure survey indicates that poverty has come down to five per cent in the country and people are becoming prosperous both in rural and urban areas, NITI Aayog CEO B V R Subrahmanyam said on Sunday.
- → The National Sample Survey Office (NSSO), under the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, released data on household consumption expenditure for the year 2022-23 on Saturday which shows per capita monthly household expenditure more than doubled in 2022-23 as as compared to 2011-12.



IIM:

- → The country's first 'Gati Shakti Research Chair' will be established at the Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Shillong. The Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (MoPSW) has collaborated with IIM-Shillong to set up India's first 'Gati Shakti Research Chair'.
- → This initiative aims to discuss the multimodal logistics development strategy focused on connecting the North Eastern Region (NER) with wider national and international regions to fortify the local economy.

(Importance level-4/5)


- The 5th edition of the Joint Military Exercise 'Dharma Guardian' commenced today at the Mahajan Field Firing Ranges in Rajasthan, India.

(Importance level-4/5)



Philippines:

- → On World Day of Social Justice, 20 February 2024, the Philippines deposited the instrument of ratification of the Violence and Harassment Convention, 2019 (No. 190), with the Deputy Director-General of the International Labour Organization (ILO).
- → By depositing the instrument of ratification, the Philippines becomes the 38th country in the world, and the first Asian country, to ratify Convention No. 190.



Ravichandran Ashwin:

- → Indian off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin etched his name in cricketing history, surpassing legendary leg-spinner Anil Kumble to become the leading wicket-taker in Test matches played on Indian soil.
- → The feat unfolded during the third day of the ongoing fourth Test match between India and England in Ranchi.
- → Ashwin dismissed Ben Duckett and Ollie Pope, taking his tally to 351 wickets in Tests played in India. This eclipsed Kumble's previous record of 350 wickets achieved in 63 matches.



Khelo India Winter Games 2024:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → The Khelo India Winter Games 2024 concluded in Gulmarg, with the Army emerging victorious after a thrilling final day of competition.
- → Alpine skier Bobby Pandey's gold medal in the parallel slalom event proved decisive, propelling Army to the top of the medal table with 10 gold medals.
- → This narrow margin placed them one gold ahead of Karnataka (9 gold) and three ahead of
 - Maharashtra (7 gold), who had led after the first round in Ladakh.

- → In a first-of-its-kind initiative, Election Commission of India (ECI) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with two prominent organizations, the Indian Banks' Association (IBA) and the Department of Posts (DoP) to amplify its voter outreach and awareness efforts ahead of the forthcoming General Elections to Lok Sabha 2024.
- The initiative is in continuation of ECI's untiring efforts to enhance electoral awareness in the country.
- → Notably, ECI had recently signed an MoU with the Ministry of Education to formally integrate electoral literacy into the educational curriculum of schools and colleges.



Anti-Muslim hate speech:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → BJP-ruled states accounted for 75% of anti-Muslim hate speech events in 2023, says report. Out of 668 documented anti-Muslim hate speech incidents in India last year, 498 or 75% took place in the Bharatiya Janata Party-ruled states, a report by Washington-based research group India Hate Lab said.
- The researchers used the United Nations' definition of hate speech which describes it as pejorative or discriminatory language towards an individual or group based on attributes including religion, ethnicity, nationality, race or gender.



Septic tank cleaning robot:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → India's first septic tank cleaning robot, offering an end-to-end solution to eliminate manual scavenging, is strengthening the Swachhata Abhiyan in different corners of the country.
- → The technology called Homosep Atom solves manual cleaning methods and transforms them into robotic cleaning methods. It has been developed by the startup incubated in the Department of Science and Technology (DST)-Technology Business Incubator (TBI) of IIT Madras.





Jefferies:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → Global investment advisory firm Jefferies has projected an optimistic outlook for the Indian economy and its equity markets.
- → The New York-headquartered firm said that in the last ten years, India has seen fundamental structural reforms that have created the framework for the country to realise its full potential.
- → India's GDP will likely touch five trillion US dollars making it the third largest economy by 2027, overtaking Japan and Germany, maintaining the status of fastest-growing large economy.

- → US Consul General Mike Hankey emphasized the importance of cybersecurity in the bilateral relationship between the United States and India.



Gaganyaan:

(Importance level-5/5)


- → Prime Minister Narendra Modi disclosed the identities of the four pilots currently undergoing training for India's first human space flight mission, Gaganyaan, during his visit to the Vikram Sarabhai Space Center (VSSC) in Kerala's Thiruvananthapuram.
- → The astronauts, Group Captain P Balakrishnan Nair, Group Captain Ajit Krishnan, Group Captain Angad Pratap, and Wing Commander S Shukla, were also awarded 'astronaut wings' by the Prime Minister.



An international collaboration of researchers:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → For the first time, an international collaboration of researchers has successfully demonstrated the laser cooling of Positronium, a short-lived hydrogen-like atom that provides an ideal testing ground for bound-state quantum electrodynamics.
- → In the recently published paper in the Physical Review Letters, the AEgIS team has described the laser cooling of Positronium atoms achieved from ~380 Kelvin (106.85 degrees Celsius) to ~170 Kelvin (minus 103.15 degrees Celsius), using a 70-nanosecond pulsed alexandrite-based laser system.



Maryam Nawaz:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → Maryam Nawaz, the daughter of Pakistan's former Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif and a senior leader of the Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) party, has achieved a significant political milestone by becoming the first woman Chief Minister of Punjab province.
- → Maryam Nawaz secured victory in the chief ministerial elections despite facing a walkout by lawmakers from Imran Khan's party-backed Sunni Ittehad Council.

- → The decision stems from legal entanglements surrounding the project. As an alternative strategy, the government plans to establish Pharma Villages to decentralize the growth of the
 - pharmaceutical industry across the state.



Uttarakhand government:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → The Uttarakhand government will introduce a bill to hold rioters responsible for damage to both government and private property. In the upcoming budget session, they intend to present the Uttarakhand Public and Private Property Damage Recovery Bill, aiming to make rioters financially liable for losses resulting from protests or strikes.
- → Uttarakhand is poised to become the third state, after Uttar Pradesh and Haryana, to enact such a law.



RBI:

- → The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is promoting financial literacy among young adults through their annual Financial Literacy Week (FLW) campaign, held from February 26 to March 1, 2024.
- → This year's theme, "Make a Right Start Become Financially Smart," with emphasis on "Saving and Power of Compounding", "Banking Essentials for Students" and "Digital and Cyber Hygiene" which aligns with overall strategic objectives of the National Strategy for Financial Education: 2020-2025.
- → The theme for this year is targeted towards young adults, mainly students. The objective is to increase awareness on the advantages of inculcating discipline from an early age.



National Science Day:

- → National Science Day is celebrated annually on 28th February in India to commemorate the discovery of the 'Raman Effect' by Indian physicist Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman. This day serves as a reminder of the pivotal role science plays in shaping our lives and society.
- → Each year, National Science Day is celebrated with a specific theme, highlighting significant aspects of scientific progress and innovation.
- → The theme for National Science Day 2024 is 'Indigenous Technologies for Viksit Bharat', emphasizing the importance of promoting scientific, technological, and innovation skills.



World's largest grain storage plan:

- → Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched the world's largest grain storage plan in the cooperative sector, entailing an investment of over Rs 1.25 lakh crore, with the inauguration of 11 godowns in primary agricultural credit societies (PACS) in as many states.
- → Under the programme, 700 lakh tons of storage capacity will be created over the next five years in the cooperative sector by constructing thousands of godowns and warehouses.





Ministry of Ayush:

- → The Ministry of Ayush has signed an MoU with the Research and Information System (RIS) in New Delhi.
- → The MoU will bring forth the overview of Ayush Service sector and will serve the continuation of academic cooperation and collaboration with RIS, which is a Policy Research autonomous institute of the Ministry of External Affairs.

Assam assembly:

- → The Assam assembly on Monday passed a bill that proposes a punishment of up to 10 years in jail and a fine of up to ₹10 crore on anyone found indulging in unfair means in recruitment examinations.
- → The Assam Public Examination (Measures for Prevention of Unfair Means in Recruitment) Bill, 2024 was passed by a voice vote in the House on the last day of the Budget session.
- → The bill, moved by Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma, will give full immunity to any government officer implementing the clauses in "good faith".



Jamaat-e-Islami Jammu Kashmir:

- → Government of India has declared 'Jamaat-e-Islami Jammu Kashmir' as an 'Unlawful Association' for a further period of 5 years under Section 3(1) of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) 1967.
- → The organisation is found continuing its activities against the security, integrity and sovereignty of the nation.



ISRO:

- → Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for the Indian Space Research Organisation's (ISRO) second spaceport in Kulasekarapattinam, Tamil Nadu.
- → This marks a significant milestone in India's space exploration endeavors, promising to revolutionize the nation's satellite launch capabilities.
- → The project is estimated to cost Rs 950 crore. It aims to cater to the growing demand for satellite launches, particularly for small satellites. Its location promises fuel savings and more efficient satellite launches compared to the existing facility in Sriharikota.
- The new spaceport allows satellites to travel directly southwards, saving fuel and reducing turnaround time. ISRO scientists highlight its potential to enhance payload capability and efficiency.

Grand Mosque of Algiers:

- → Algerian President Abdelmadjid Tebboune has inaugurated the Grand Mosque of Algiers on the North African nation's Mediterranean coastline.
- → Known locally as the Djamaa El-Djazair, it features the world's tallest minaret at 265 metres (869 feet), can accommodate 120,000 people, and is the world's largest mosque only after Islam's holiest sites in Saudi Arabia's Mecca and Medina.
- ➔ It was built over seven years in the form of a modernist structure extending across 27.75 hectares (almost 70 acres), decorated in wood and marble and containing Arab and North African flourishes. It reportedly has a helicopter landing pad and a library capable of housing up to one million books.





US Chamber of Commerce:

- → The US Chamber of Commerce recently unveiled the 12th edition of its International Intellectual Property (IP) Index, offering a comprehensive evaluation of the IP landscape across the globe. This year's index ranked 55 economies, assessing their IP frameworks' effectiveness in fostering innovation and creative industries.
- ➤ The United States retained its position at the pinnacle, followed closely by the United Kingdom and France, highlighting the critical role of robust IP systems in economic development. India secured the 42nd position out of the 55 countries evaluated, with an overall score of 38.64 percent.



NATO:

- → The North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) launched its largest military exercise in Europe in decades, Steadfast Defender 2024, in late January 2024.
- → This large-scale operation, conducted against the backdrop of the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict, serves as a potent symbol of NATO's collective military might and unwavering commitment to the security of its member states.





Jan Nicol Loftie-Eaton:

- → Jan Nicol Loftie-Eaton, the dynamic Namibian batter, etched his name in cricketing history by scoring the fastest T20 International (T20I) century in a blistering innings against Nepal.
- → Loftie-Eaton's extraordinary feat occurred during the first T20I of the Tri-Nation series on Tuesday, February 27, leaving fans and pundits in awe of his remarkable display of powerhitting.
- ➔ Facing Nepal's bowling attack, Loftie-Eaton demonstrated his prowess with the bat as he notched up a scintillating hundred off just 33 deliveries, eclipsing the previous record held by Nepal's Kushal Malla.

- Nagaland government has launched a fully-funded universal life insurance scheme to mitigate financial hardship caused by untimely demise.
- → The scheme ensures financial security and protection, providing coverage for breadwinners and family members, complementing the Chief Minister's Health Insurance Scheme.
- → The Chief Minister's Universal Life Insurance Scheme will be fully funded by the state government.
- → Under this, a life insurance coverage of Rs 2 lakh will be given and additionally, accidental insurance coverage of Rs 2 lakh each will also be provided for the breadwinner and three other family members.



Vantara:

(Importance level-3/5)

Reliance Industries and Reliance Foundation have launched 'Vantara' (Star of the Forest) programme.

- → The programme will focus on rescue, treatment, care and rehabilitation of injured, abused and threatened animals, both in India and abroad.
- → The Vantara initiative has been conceptualized under the leadership of Anant Ambani, a Director on the boards of RIL and Reliance Foundation.
- → Vantara aims to partner with the Zoo Authority of India and other relevant government organisations. It will help improve all the 150-plus zoos in India in terms of training, capacity building and animal care infrastructure.



India's first indigenously built hydrogen fuel cell:

(Importance level-4/5)

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has flagged off India's first indigenously built hydrogen
 fuel cell ferry boat in virtual mode. The vessel has been built at the Cochin Shipyard.
- → The pilot vessel is a 24-metre catamaran which can carry 50 passengers with fully air-conditioned passenger space.
- → It will make urban mobility smooth and easy. The hydrogen fuel vessel has fully home-grown technology and it can be replicated in other parts of the country for urban mobility application.



Arkaja Das:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → The Central Government has approved the appointment of Arkaja Das (IPoS) as Director in the Ministry of Women & Child Development.
- → Das has been appointed under the Central Staffing Scheme with effect from 1 March 2024 and for a period up to 26 October 2027.
- → Das is an Indian Postal Service (IPoS) officer of 2010-batch. Presently, she is posted as Deputy Secretary in the same Ministry.

Space station:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → Prime Minister Narendra Modi has declared India's plan to establish its own space station by 2035. This initiative aims to facilitate advanced exploration of the universe.
- → Among other feats, India now aims for setting up 'Bharatiya Antariksha Station' by 2035 and sending the first Indian to the Moon by 2040.
- ➔ Indian is about to go to space after a gap of 40 years, in an apparent reference to Rakesh Sharma's 1984 space flight aboard USSR's Soyuz T-11.



NSG:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → The National Security Guard (NSG) of India is making significant strides in bolstering its anti-terrorism capabilities by introducing the Belgian Malinois into its K9 unit.
- → This shift, aimed at enhancing the efficiency of operations such as sniffing, tracking, and attacking, marks a departure from the traditional use of Labradors and German Shepherds.
- → With the induction of these highly intelligent and trainable dogs, the NSG is setting a new standard in counter-terrorism and hostage rescue.





Morarji Desai:

(Importance level-3/5)

- → Prime Minister Narendra Modi paid homage to former Prime Minister Morarji Desai on his birth anniversary on 29th February.
- ➔ Morarji Ranchhodji Desai was an Indian independence activist and politician who served as the 4th Prime Minister of India between 1977 and 1979 leading the government formed by the Janata Party. He received Bharat Ratna in 1991.





FMR:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → The Mizoram Assembly adopted a resolution against the central government's decision to fence the Indo-Myanmar border and scrap the Free Movement Regime (FMR) with the neighbouring country.
- → The FMR allows people living on both sides of the border to travel 16 km into each other's territory without a visa.






New Zealand:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → New Zealand will repeal a world-first law banning tobacco sales for future generations. Set to take effect from July, the toughest anti-tobacco rules in the world would have banned sales to those born after January 1, 2009, cut nicotine content in smoked tobacco products and reduced the number of tobacco retailers by more than 90 per cent.
- → Repeal flies in the face of robust research evidence, ignores measures strongly supported by Maori leaders and will preserve health inequities.



Rare Disease Day:

(Importance level-4/5)

- → Rare Disease Day is observed on 29 February. Objective To create awareness on the rare diseases that exist and how they can affect the daily lives of the patients. The theme for 2024, "Share Your Colours," emphasizes collaboration and support.
- → Rare Disease Day was first observed in 2008 by EURORDIS and the Council of National Alliances to raise awareness about rare diseases. It falls on the last day of February, but in leap years like 2024, it is observed on February 29th.


Singapore:

(Importance level-4/5)

→ Singapore, facing a dwindling population and a manpower shortage, has seen its resident total fertility rate (TFR) drop to an estimated 0.97 per cent in 2023, the first time it has dropped below one per cent in the country's history.
