Since then, the state has played a significant role in promoting indigenous culture, biodiversity conservation, and peace-building within the region.
- Celebrations on Statehood Day highlight both the state's historical journey and its contemporary contributions, reflecting the resilience and unity of the Naga people.
- After India's independence in 1947, the Naga-inhabited region remained part of Assam. Nagaland formally became India's 16th state, and the first elected government assumed office in 1964.



Javokhir Sindarov:

- Javokhir Sindarov Becomes Youngest Ever FIDE World Cup Champion, Wins \$120,000 19-year-old Uzbek GM Javokhir Sindarov became the youngest ever FIDE World Cup winner by defeating GM Wei Yi 1.5-0.5 in tiebreaks, earning the \$120,000 top prize.
- The 2025 FIDE World Cup in Goa, India featured 206 players in a single-elimination knockout format from November 1–26, determining three spots for the 2026 FIDE Candidates Tournament.



Aadhaar:


- The governments of Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra have instructed all departments to stop using Aadhaar as proof of birth. Aadhaar (Unique Identification Authority of India – UIDAI ID card) is not accepted because it does not contain any official birth record.



World Computer Literacy Day:



- The Direct Benefit Transfer of LPG (PAHAL) scheme continues to strengthen India's LPG subsidy framework with transparent and consumer-focused reforms.
- Launched in January 2015, PAHAL ensures that all domestic LPG cylinders are sold at a uniform retail price nationwide, while subsidies are credited directly into consumers' bank accounts. This model promotes clarity, reduces leakages and makes subsidy delivery more accountable.

Atal Pension Yojana:

- The Atal Pension Yojana (APY), India's flagship pension scheme for workers in the unorganised and low-income sectors, has recorded 8.34 crore enrolments as of 31 October 2025.
- This milestone reflects growing awareness about pension security and improved financial inclusion efforts nationwide. Significantly, women constitute 48% of total subscribers, highlighting rising female participation in long-term social security schemes.
- APY was launched on 9 May 2015 with the mission of ensuring universal social security for all citizens, especially those with limited income stability.
- Any Indian citizen aged between 18 and 40 years with a bank or post office savings account can join the scheme. Subscribers receive a monthly pension after turning 60, meaning pension payouts will begin from 2035 onwards for early enrollees.



Ananth:

- India has taken a big step towards self-reliance in high-tech navigation systems. ISRO Chairman V. Narayanan inaugurated Ananth Centre of Excellence for Navigation (ACEN) in Thiruvananthapuram. This is India's first private-sector navigation innovation hub, started by Ananth Technologies.
- Ananth Technologies was founded in 1992. The company has supported many important ISRO and DRDO missions. It is known for making precision sensors, working on airworthiness certifications, and helping in satellite and launch vehicle integration.

IMO:

- India has been re-elected to the IMO Council (Category B) for 2026–27, securing 154 out of 169 valid votes, the highest in its category at the 34th IMO Assembly in London. The strong vote tally highlights the global community's confidence in India's leadership in international maritime affairs and reflects the success of India's maritime growth agenda.
- The IMO Council acts as the executive body with 40 elected members, and India's delegation also held meetings with various countries and organisations on maritime cooperation during the Assembly.

National Pollution Control Day:

Goat & Sheep Breeding Policy:

- The Tamil Nadu Goat & Sheep Breeding Policy was recently unveiled by the State Government. It has advocated for an open nucleus breeding system for goats and for selective breeding within the breed with superior rams for sheep.
- The policy aims to improve sheep and goat for better production, to conserve local breeds and to explore registration of native/local breeds in ICAR-NBAGR. As per the 20th Livestock Census, the sheep population was 45 lakhs, and the goat population was 98 lakhs in Tamil Nadu.

Nilgiris Tahr:

- A Nilgiris Tahr Interpretation Centre will be established in Gandhi Puram near Semmozhi Poonga, Coimbatore. Last year, Tamil Nadu recorded 1,031 Nilgiri Tahr during a count conducted across 13 routes and 140 locations.
- Anamalai Grass Hills recorded the highest number in Tamil Nadu with 334 Nilgiri Tahr. Kerala recorded 1,352 Nilgiris Tahr, bringing the combined total for Tamil Nadu and Kerala to 2,655.

- The facility features bioreactors up to 500 litres, advanced upstream and downstream systems, analytical labs, and training centres. A bioprocess design centre was developed in partnership with Thermo Fisher Scientific, with ₹90 crore investment from the firm.




e-Swathu:

Deen Dayal Lado Lakshmi Yojana:

- In a move aimed at strengthening women's economic empowerment, the Government of Haryana has modified the disbursement structure of the Deen Dayal Lado Lakshmi Yojana (DDLLY). Starting December 2025, financial assistance under the scheme will be released on a quarterly basis, with beneficiaries receiving a lump sum of ₹6,300 every three months instead of ₹2,100 monthly.
- This update was announced by Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, who confirmed the change while releasing the scheme's second instalment. The decision reflects an effort to streamline welfare distribution while preserving the core objective of boosting social security and financial stability for women in the state.



- India's rich heritage, architectural masterpieces, and cultural diversity continue to attract millions of travellers every year. Among the 145 centrally protected ticketed monuments under the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), the Taj Mahal in Agra emerged as the most visited monument—a title it continues to retain year after year.
- With its global heritage appeal, architectural beauty, and UNESCO World Heritage status, the Taj Mahal remains the primary symbol of India's tourism identity.



Malnutrition:

- Recent government data tabled in Parliament reveals that malnutrition among children below five years continues to be a serious challenge in India, even though real-time monitoring shows gradual improvement.
- The information originates from the Poshan Tracker system, which compiles measurements of children enrolled in Anganwadi centres nationwide. According to the latest Poshan Tracker records, over 6.44 crore children were assessed for their height and weight.
- The analysis shows that 33.54 per cent of children are stunted, indicating chronic undernutrition, 14.41 per cent are underweight, and 5.03 per cent are wasted, reflecting acute growth deficiency. These indicators give a real-time picture of child nutrition status under community-based surveillance.

Defence Research and Development Organisation:

- The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has achieved a major breakthrough by carrying out a high-speed rocket-sled test of a fighter aircraft escape system in Chandigarh.
- This important trial proved that the pilot-saving technology works safely and effectively during emergencies. The test took place at the Rail Track Rocket Sled (RTRS) facility of the Terminal Ballistics Research Laboratory (TBRL). This advanced track allows scientists to check how escape systems perform at very high speeds, similar to real flying conditions.

- Students will receive training and will spread awareness about conserving golden jackals and helping injured animals return to the forest. The plan also covers awareness about other small wildlife such as mongoose, anteater, tortoise, snakes, and monitor lizard.




December 6:

- Every year on December 6, India observes Mahaparinirvan Diwas to pay tribute to Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar, one of the country's greatest social reformers and the architect of the Indian Constitution.
- The year 2025 marks his 68th death anniversary, and the day is solemnly commemorated, especially at Chaitya Bhoomi in Mumbai, where thousands gather to honour his legacy. Dr. Ambedkar's lifelong battle against caste-based discrimination and his role in ensuring social justice through constitutional means continue to shape India's democratic and inclusive ideals.
- The term "Mahaparinirvan" is derived from Buddhist philosophy, signifying the state of ultimate liberation from the cycle of birth and death (samsara).
- In Buddhism, it represents the final nirvana attained after physical death — a state beyond suffering and rebirth. Dr. Ambedkar, who embraced Buddhism in October 1956 along with over 500,000 followers, is remembered with this term, symbolising his spiritual and ideological transition and the impact of his final departure on Indian society.

NFIES:

- With rising crime complexity and new legal mandates requiring forensic evidence, India is strengthening its forensic ecosystem.
- To address these challenges, the government launched the National Forensic Infrastructure Enhancement Scheme (NFIES), aimed at building state-of-the-art laboratories and trained manpower. The NFIES is a Central Sector Scheme launched in 2024 to build robust forensic capabilities across India.

- Tamil Nadu Police used Artificial Intelligence (AI) for the first time to manage the crowd and vehicles at the Karthigai Deepam festival in Tiruvannamalai. The AI system was connected to hundreds of CCTV (Closed-Circuit Television) cameras around the temple, streets, and girivalam routes.
- The system gave crowd density alerts when 4–5 people gathered in one square metre, helping police prevent overcrowding. The technology showed 95% accurate data on the number of people and vehicles at each location.

- Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport in Delhi is India's first water-positive airport, handling over 40 million passengers. A water-positive place recharges more freshwater than it uses.
- The airport has 625 rainwater harvesting structures and two reservoirs storing 9 million litres of water. A 16.6 million-litres-per-day (MLD) zero-liquid-discharge sewage plant recycles all wastewater. Recycled water is used for air-conditioning, gardening and toilets through automated systems.
- The certification was given under the NITI Aayog – Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) water neutrality framework.



Assam Cabinet:

- Assam Cabinet approved a report recommending Scheduled Tribe (ST) status for six communities. The communities are Tai Ahoms, Tea Tribes (Adivasis), Moran, Matak (Motok), Chutia, and Koch-Rajbongshi. Granting ST status aims to address long-standing demands and provide social and economic benefits to these groups.
- Article 366 (25) defines STs as communities deemed under Article 342 to be Scheduled Tribes for the purposes of the Constitution. Article 342 Clause (1) - The President of India is empowered to specify the communities to be deemed as STs in a particular State or Union Territory.
- Article 342 Clause (2) - It grants the Parliament the exclusive power to include or exclude any community from the ST list through a legislative Act and once Parliament enacts a law, the Presidential order cannot be modified by a subsequent notification.

- INDIA bloc MPs submit letter to LS Speaker to move impeachment motion against Justice Swaminathan. They sought to move a motion for his removal under Article 217, read with Article 124, of the Constitution of India.
- They stated that the conduct of Justice Swaminathan raised serious questions regarding impartiality, transparency, and the secular functioning of the judiciary. The MPs submitted copies of letters written by members of the Rajya Sabha and the Lok Sabha to the President of India and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.
- One hundred members of the Lok Sabha or 50 members of the Rajya Sabha have to sign an impeachment motion against a High Court judge. If the motion is accepted, a three-member committee will investigate it.
- Thereafter, both Houses must pass the motion by a special majority (two-thirds present and voting, plus absolute majority of total membership). Finally, the President will issue the removal order. However, no judge has been successfully impeached in India.

- Rajasthan is carrying out its first inter-state tiger translocation by bringing a tigress (Tigress PN-224) from Pench Tiger Reserve in Madhya Pradesh. This is the India's second tiger translocation.
- The tigress will be airlifted to Ramgarh Vishdhari Tiger Reserve (RVTR) to help increase tiger numbers and improve genetic diversity. RVTR is in the Bundi district of Rajasthan, notified in May 2022, and covers 1,501.89 sq km with a core and buffer zone.
- The reserve forms a natural corridor between the Ranthambore Tiger Reserve and Mukundara Hills Tiger Reserve, helping tiger movement. The translocation aims to strengthen the new habitat and support long-term conservation under Project Tiger.



Tamil Nadu:

- Tamil Nadu issued the Alienation of Immovable Property of the Religious Institutions Rules, 2025 for temple land sale, exchange, lease, and mortgage. The rules were notified through a Government Order on December 1, 2025.
- Temple land value must be fixed using the higher of the market value or guideline value. Sale value is set at 225% in urban areas, 275% within 30 km, 325% within 30–50 km, and 425% beyond 50 km from urban areas. Lands offered in exchange must have a clear title, no encumbrances, and must not be in restricted or eco-sensitive zones.

Chang'e-6:





Supreme Court:

- The Supreme Court set aside the Patna High Court order allowing involuntary narco tests in *Amlesh Kumar v. State of Bihar* (2025). Narco tests involve sedating an accused using drugs such as Sodium Pentothal to extract information, similar to polygraphs or brain mapping.
- The Forced narco tests violate Article 20(3) of the Constitution, which protects individuals against self-incrimination. Conducting narco tests without consent also breaches Article 21 (Right to Life and Personal Liberty) and the Right to Privacy, forming part of the constitutional “Golden Triangle” with Articles 14 and 19.
- The Courts have held that narco test results cannot confirm guilt and must be corroborated with other evidence.







MGNREGA:

- The government is likely to introduce an amendment Bill in the ongoing Winter Session of Parliament to rename MGNREGA as “Puja Bapu Gramin Rozgar Yojana”, with the proposal reportedly cleared by the Union Cabinet.
- The amended Bill may also propose increasing the guaranteed employment days from 100 to 125 days per household, even as the average employment provided over the last five years has been about 50.35 days per household.
- The amendments are expected to factor in the recommendations of the Amarjeet Sinha-led review panel, including possible exclusionary clauses based on State-level economic indicators and addressing inter-State disparities in scheme expenditure.
- The government may further revise the funding pattern and introduce stronger compliance checks, particularly to prevent Centre-State fund-related disputes, such as the prolonged standoff with West Bengal over scheme implementation.

SHANTI:

- The Union Cabinet has approved the Sustainable Harnessing and Advancement of Nuclear Energy for Transforming India (SHANTI) Bill, marking a major policy shift by opening India's nuclear power sector to private participation to help achieve 100 GW nuclear capacity by 2047 and strengthen energy security.
- The Bill allows private companies to participate in civil nuclear power generation under strict government oversight, while strategic functions such as nuclear material production, heavy water management, and radioactive waste handling will remain under the Department of Atomic Energy.
- It proposes amendments to the civil nuclear liability framework, caps supplier liability, redesigns operator insurance cover at ₹1,500 crore per incident, permits up to 49% FDI, and introduces a unified atomic energy law with a specialised nuclear tribunal to boost investor confidence.
- The reforms align with India's net-zero target by 2070, positioning nuclear energy as a stable, low-carbon base-load source alongside renewables; the government has also announced a ₹20,000 crore Nuclear Energy Mission and plans to operationalise five indigenous Small Modular Reactors (SMRs) by 2033.

Gross State Domestic Product:

- The State of Tamilnadu topped other States by recording a Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) growth rate of 16 %. This growth figure was reported by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- The report 'Handbook of Statistics on Indian States, 2024-25' was released by the RBI. Between 2021 and 2025, Tamil Nadu's economy grew by ₹10.50 lakh crore. The total GSDP value of Tamil Nadu stands at ₹31.19 lakh crore. The State's per capita income crossed ₹1.9 lakh per year, marking a major economic milestone.
- The GSDP at current prices increased from Rs 26.88 lakh crore in 2023-24 to Rs 31.18 lakh crore in 2024-25. In this regard, Tamilnadu was outpacing Maharashtra and Gujarat. Maharashtra, despite having the largest GSDP in absolute terms, reported slower growth compared with Tamil Nadu.
- Karnataka saw consistent double-digit performance but remained behind Tamil Nadu in 2024-25 in terms of the pace of expansion. Tamilnadu ranks fourth in per capita income, behind Delhi, Telangana and Karnataka.






Orderly system:

- Section 63 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 (Section 375 of the IPC) – Marital rape is not a specific criminal offence under the penal code if the wife is over 18 years of age. Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act (2005) – Marital rape is treated as a form of domestic violence, and prescribes a lighter penalty compared to non-marital rape.



- Under the revised structure, an MLA will receive ₹3.45 lakh per month, up from ₹1.10 lakh in 2007. The Chief Minister's monthly pay is ₹3.74 lakh, including salary of ₹1 lakh, car allowance of ₹91,000, and sumptuary allowance of ₹1.83 lakh.
- The Deputy CM will get ₹3.68 lakh, Cabinet Ministers ₹3.62 lakh, and Ministers of State ₹3.56 lakh per month.
- The Speaker's salary is ₹3.68 lakh, the Deputy Speaker's ₹3.56 lakh, and the Leader of Opposition and Government Chief Whip's ₹3.62 lakh. Odisha's per capita income is ₹1,82,548 per year, below the national average of ₹2,05,324.



President of India:

- The President of India rejected the West Bengal Assembly amendment bill proposing the CM as Chancellor of state universities.
- Governor Dr. C. V. Bose had reserved the bill for the President's consideration on 20 April 2024. Another amendment bill related to Aliah University, proposing the CM as Amire-Jamia or Chancellor, was also rejected.
- The existing arrangement remains unchanged, and the Governor continues as Chancellor under the current legal framework. The bills aimed to replace the Governor with the CM in the role of Chancellor, but the proposal was not approved.





Chillai Kalan:

Beginning on December 21 this 40 day period traditionally marks the harshest winter conditions in the Kashmir Valley. Also characterized by freezing temperatures, snowfall, and icy winds.
- Chillai Kalan is a centuries-old Kashmiri term referring to the 40 day peak winter period, lasting from December 21 to January 30. During this time, temperatures often plunge well below freezing, water bodies partially freeze, and heavy snowfall is common in higher reaches.
- This phase is followed by Chillai Khurd (20 days of milder cold) and Chillai Bacha (10 days of comparatively moderate winter), making Chillai Kalan the most critical period for weather and water cycles.

- A new study has once again highlighted the severe air pollution crisis in Delhi-NCR. According to an analysis by the Health Effects Institute (HEI) all of the top 20 most polluted air quality monitoring stations in India in 2024 were located in Delhi and the National Capital Region (NCR).
- This assessment reviewed air quality trends after the launch of the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) in 2019 and shows that while there are signs of improvement at some locations, absolute pollution levels in Delhi-NCR remain among the highest in the country.

- A groundbreaking discovery astronomers using the James Webb Space Telescope have identified one of the most unusual planets ever observed. An exoplanet stretched into a lemon like shape due to intense gravitational forces.

- The discovery highlights the telescope's unparalleled ability to study extreme cosmic environments and expands our understanding of how diverse planetary systems can be. The newly discovered planet is named PSR J2322-2650b. It is roughly Jupiter sized but orbits its host pulsar at an extraordinarily close distance of about one million miles, which is just 1% of the Earth Sun distance.
- Due to this proximity the planet completes one orbit in just 7.8 Earth hours, making its 'year' shorter than a typical workday on Earth.



Mallankinaru:

- A possible Middle Palaeolithic period site was identified after quartz stone tools were discovered at Mallankinaru in Virudhunagar district of Tamil Nadu. The artefacts include multidirectional cores, radial cores, flakes, notches, and scrapers.
- The stone tools were found in a stratified quarry section near a waterbody at Mallankinaru. Preliminary analysis indicates that the tools may belong to the Middle Palaeolithic period. The site is part of the lower Gundar basin and was formed due to fluvial (riverrelated) activity.

The Court held that CSR spending on environmental protection is a constitutional obligation and not charity. This obligation arises under Article 51A(g) of the Constitution of India.
- The judgment was delivered in the case of MK Ranjitsinh and Others versus Union of India. The case was related to the protection of the Great Indian Bustard, an endangered bird species. The Court stated that companies must bear conservation costs if their activities harm wildlife and ecosystems.





- Russia's Bezymianny volcano blew itself apart 69 years ago, in a massive eruption on 30 March 1956. The eruption caused the summit to collapse, turning the cone-shaped mountain into a horseshoe-shaped amphitheatre. The volcano has been regrowing through frequent eruptions, including a major one in November 2025.
- A 2020 study reported that Bezymianny is expected to reach its pre-1956 height between 2030 and 2035. The volcano emits explosive ash clouds and pyroclastic flows while also growing via non-explosive lava flows (effusive eruptions).




Sardar Udham Singh:

- Established in 2003, the Kimberley Process Certification Scheme (KPCS) has 60 participants (with the EU counted as one) and regulates over 99% of global rough diamond trade, making it the most comprehensive mechanism in the sector. During its tenure, India will focus on strengthening governance and compliance, promoting digital certification and traceability, enhancing transparency, and building global trust in conflict-free diamonds.



VB-G RAM G:

- The President of India has given assent to the Viksit Bharat-Guarantee for Rozgar and Ajeevika Mission (Gramin) (VB-G RAM G) Bill, 2025. 
Archaeological evidence:

- Archaeological evidence shows that floods buried the Keezhadi settlement on the Vaigai floodplain in Tamil Nadu around 1,155 years ago. Keezhadi is located in the Sivagangai district and lies on a mound within the Vaigai river floodplain. Excavations have revealed brick structures, canals, floors, and pottery reflecting urban life described in Sangam literature.
- The sediment layers indicate repeated flooding, with coarser sand below brick structures and silty clay above, suggesting high-energy flood events. These findings help understand late Holocene climate variability and how environmental forces shaped human settlements in South India.

National Family Health Survey:

- India has pledged to end child marriage by 2030 under the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDG). The government launched the Bal Vivah Mukt Bharat Abhiyan and marked its first anniversary with a 100-day awareness campaign against child marriage. National Family Health Survey (NFHS) data show child marriage among women aged 18–29 declined from 47.4% in 2005–06 to 23.3% in 2019–21.
- Highest rates of child marriage are in West Bengal, Bihar, and Tripura, while Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Telangana, Madhya Pradesh, and Rajasthan also show significant cases.
- 40% of girls from the poorest households marry before 18, compared to 8% from the wealthiest households. 48% of girls with no education are married before adulthood, compared to only 4% among educated girls. The Prevention of Child Marriage Act was enacted to prevent this in 2006.

- It exports to countries like Germany, Iran, Iraq, Morocco, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, Brazil, the Netherlands, and Bangladesh. Turmeric cultivation in Erode covers over 30% of Tamil Nadu's 1.60 lakh acres under the spice, producing more than two lakh bags annually.



Group C:

- The Union Home Ministry has increased reservation for ex-Agniveers in Group C posts of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) from 10% to 50%. 50% of vacant constable posts in the Border Security Force (BSF) will now be reserved for ex-Agniveers.
- Ex-Agniveers are exempted from Physical Standard Test (PST) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET) but must appear for written examinations.

Vallanadu sanctuary:

- The blackbuck (*Antilope cervicapra*) population in Vallanadu sanctuary, Tamil Nadu, increased to 300 in the 2023–2024 census, up from 260 in 2022–2023. Vallanadu sanctuary, established in 1987, spans 1,641 hectares and is a natural habitat for the endangered blackbuck, listed in Schedule I of The Wildlife Protection Act, 1972. Grassland restoration under the Tamil Nadu Biodiversity Conservation and Greening Project for Climate Change Response (TBGPCCR) has restored around 50 hectares of native grass, improving habitat conditions for blackbucks.
- The sanctuary also houses 300 spotted deer, 150 sambar deer. The Blackbuck (*Antilope cervicapra*) is listed as Least Concern globally by the IUCN Red List. It is located on an isolated hillock in Vallanadu Village of Srivaikundam Taluk, Thoothukudi. It is the southernmost place in India where a natural population of blackbuck exists.





Agriculture:

Despite weak agricultural performance, the State's economy has grown well due to the strong performance of the secondary and tertiary sectors.
- Total food grain production (rice, pulses, and coarse cereals) ranged between 107 and 120 lakh tonnes. The highest production was 119.98 lakh tonnes in 2021–22, after the COVID-19 pandemic, and the lowest was 107 lakh tonnes in 2023–24. Rice is the main food grain in the State, followed by coarse cereals, especially millets, while pulses contribute only a small share.


Supreme Court:
